All places have to be booked via Libacura. Libacura is an internet booking system and you first have to be registered with Sparks. There is an annual registration fee of £20 per child for all new parents which will be applied once registered.

Please go to our **website [www.sparks-inc.org](http://www.sparks-inc.org)** and go to the second tab labelled About Sparks and go to third line Registration and Booking, this page will guide you through the process. Once you are registered with Libacura, you can pay in advance using a system called Go Cardless. For Holiday Club you need to pay for the sessions first before you can book them.

If you book and pay by the 22<sup>nd</sup> March there is a 10% early bird discount.

You must book by 5<sup>th</sup> April to be sure of a place.

Emergency bookings can be taken during the holiday club duration if there is space.

## **Important things to remember:**

- Please provide a packed lunch and drink for the days your child is attending.
- Please only send children in old clothes so that new clothes don't get covered in paint and mud :-)
- On trip days please arrive by 9am. Your children may also need to bring waterproofs depending on weather forecast.
- We provide tasty snacks mid-morning and mid-afternoon and drinks are available all day
